HOW TO ENTER

1. Using Peeps® and a box (not to exceed 24" deep X 24" tall) create a scene that depicts **"Who are the Peeps in My Neighborhood?"**, the theme of the 2021 WisconSibs *"Sibs Are My Peeps®"* challenge.

Let the scene take your Peeps® on an adventure around your neighborhood.

NEW OPTION! Don't have Peeps® or a box in the house and can't get out to get some? No problem. Make a "flat Peep" display using paper, some crayons, and of course your imagination. Pinterest is a good place to find Peeps coloring pages or print the attached or draw your own Peeps.

2. Email no more than **two photos** of your scene to: siblingsaremypeeps@wisconsibs.org
Photos must be .jpg, .jpeg or .png. Your email must also include:
 - Names, ages and hometown/state of all who helped create the scene.
 - Phone number and e-mail address (not for publication).
 - Title of your scene. (Extra points for cleverness of course.)
 - 2-4 sentences about your creation or its significance.

Photo submissions are due by Monday, April 5, 2021 at 11:59 p.m. CST. Five semi-finalists will be selected by a panel of judges with one winner from each of these categories:

Judges will determine semi-finalists in the following categories:

- a. Best Use of Marshmallow Peeps® bunnies and chicks
- b. Peep of Perfection– Well executed design.
- c. Peeping with Creativity – Use of materials in creative ways.
- d. Peep-tastic Theme– Great story that best fits the theme "Who are the Peeps in My Neighborhood?"
- e. Little Peeps® – Created by children age 10 and under.

Entries and winning scenes will be posted on the WisconSibs Facebook page during the week of April 6-10 to celebrate **National Siblings Day, April 10, 2021.**
